

Reformation Video

You and your group are going to be creating an informational video about your section of the the Reformation in our textbook, Pathways. Your video must be 3-6 minutes in length, and give an overview of your section that everyone could understand. This video will be shown in class and you will be marked on the following:

<u>Society:</u> the everyday life and interactions.....	/10
<u>Government:</u> the role of the ruler and their power.....	/10
<u>Environment:</u> location and changes that shape society.....	/10
<u>Technology:</u> new inventions and ideas that were happening.....	/10
<u>Overall Product:</u> included requirements.....	/15

The overall requirements for this video include: a title page, images, credits, bibliography, proper video editing, speaking (giving the information), little to no writing, proper information for the section and not missing any key points.

We will be looking at some examples in the classroom to get ideas from, they will be posted on my website.

Here are the four options of sections to choose from (these will be decided in class so that there is an even number or groups per topic). Students are in groups of 3-4:
